



What is the Technical Assistance Exchange?

The U.S. Administration on Aging sponsors the Technical Assistance Exchange (TAE) to make information, resources, and expert assistance available to states and community organizations that are:

- ▶ Promoting awareness and creating a better understanding among consumers, family members and service providers about long-term care information and options;
- ▶ Streamlining access to long-term care services; and
- ▶ Ensuring person-centered and consumer-focused long-term care systems.

Initiatives supported by the TAE include:

- ▶ Aging and Disability Resource Centers (ADRCs),
- ▶ Community Living Programs (CLPs), formerly called Nursing Home Diversion Modernization (NHDM) initiatives, and
- ▶ Veteran Directed Home and Community Based Services (VDHCBS).
